The specialist will support several key initiatives of the organization focused in the Pre-K to 5th grade space, most notably Early Education and Early Literacy. They will also play a supportive role in our work extending to secondary, post-secondary, and workforce. The Specialist will have the responsibility to increase regional capacity to maximize student equity and outcomes through achieving Blueprint's 5-year objectives. The Specialist will work with the Blueprint team and with regional school district partners, cross-sector partners, and community members to implement data driven initiatives and/or strategies.
