This is a 10-month professional, full-time tenure track position beginning Fall 2019. The position may include a combination of teaching, department, college, and community leadership functions. Assignment may include day, evening, and weekend duties at all District sites.

Duties of the Position:

Teaches a full load of courses, including but not limited to, History of Cinema and Film Aesthetics. Provides leadership in the growth and development of the Cinema program at the Canyon Country Campus and at local high schools in coordination with the college's concurrent enrollment and College Now programs.

Participates in student learning outcomes and assessments.

Participates in curriculum development and revisions, including development of online curriculum and OER texts (open educational resources).

Provides leadership within the department and community relations.

Maintains office hours and participates in department, division, and college committees and governance.

Participates in and implements departmental and college program reviews.

Participates in additional faculty responsibilities, including college decision-making activities related to professional and academic matters. The activities will occur both within the department as well as in the larger College setting.
