- * Conduct organized classes at the instructional level to meet the educational requirements stated in the course description and the course information sheets.
- * Conduct related laboratory instruction, including safe handling of materials and equipment as required.
- * Advise and assist students in achieving stated course objectives.
- * Evaluate the progress of each student; notify the students in need of counseling services.
- * Attend faculty, division, or other on-campus meetings as required.
- * Participate in the evaluation of course offerings, including the revision of course descriptions and course outlines.
- * Coordinate with other faculty in the selection of textbooks, audiovisual and other instructional materials.
- * Keep current with new developments and knowledge in appropriate fields of competency within the framework of support provided by the District.
- * Maintain necessary records of student enrollment, attendance, progress and grades; prepare and submit required reports to the administration.
- * Maintain control of equipment, materials and supplies as assigned.
- * Report to the Division Chairperson, Assistant Division Chair, Director or Assistant Director any condition which might jeopardize the health or safety of students or the public.
- * Supervise student aides, tutors, and readers, as appropriate.
- * Be familiar with and act in accordance with the Education Code and Board of Trustees policies and procedures. Ability to:
 - * Prepare and present information and material in a classroom instructional situation.
 - * Sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability, and ethnic backgrounds of community college students.

Knowledge of:

- * Teaching-learning processes with special knowledge about individualizing the instruction program. When appropriate, methods and techniques of laboratory instruction including health and safety precautions.
