The Fashion Design program offers students an Associate of Applied Science in Fashion Design in the Business Area of Study as well as a Level 1 Certificate. The program, located at Highland Campus, trains students to operate industrial equipment. The department is committed to the fostering of student knowledge, skills and training. Teamwork and professional development is required in the department.
