The Jr. STEM Fab Lab Instructor (part-time) delivers direct instruction in robotics and artificial intelligence, project-based learning, and scientific inquiry to middle and high school students in the Jr. STEM Academy's in-school, out-of-school, and summer camps, and programs.

The position is primarily located at the West Philadelphia Regional Center/CATC campus, with frequent travel to the main campus, other regional centers, and partner schools throughout the city.

- Performs duties in a manner consistent with the mission, goals, and core values of the College.
- Delivers quality customer service to internal and external constituents in a professional, helpful, and courteous manner.
- Strives for excellence in teaching, applying best practices in STEM topics, and modeling behaviors that encourage student success and retention. Recognize the unique needs, culture, and context of students and advocate for their learning and well-being.
