- Give and receive constructive feedback in a professional and respectful manner.
- Clearly communicate your goals, needs, and expectations to help your mentor support your success.
- Prepare and deliver appropriate learning experiences for students.
- Develop sample syllabi, lesson plans, and course outlines.
- Reach out to the program director or department chair when additional guidance is needed.
- Participate in all required evaluations of the internship program.
- Engage fully in orientations, workshops, and other activities designed for interns.
- Fulfill other related duties as assigned.
