- Teach assigned classes in keeping with approved syllabi, outlines, and instructional materials.
- Maintain accurate student records in compliance with Lee College requirements.
- Submit required student reports to the Admissions & Records Office according to schedule.
- Direct and evaluate the learning experience of the students in accordance with adopted curricula and approved procedures.
- Provide counsel/guidance to students when there is a need.
- All faculty members are required to be on campus thirty-five (35) hours per week and participate in professional development activities, department and college committees, commencement, and other activities as stated in the Faculty Workload and Responsibilities Policy.
- Faculty members may be required to teach evening and summer classes.

Additional Duties & Responsibilities

- Service on College committees as assigned.
- Attend professional development opportunities when appropriate.
- Attend the annual graduation ceremony.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- Master's (or higher) degree in the teaching field or a Master's (or higher) degree with eighteen (18) graduate hours in the teaching field
- Candidates must pass a criminal background check by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ)
