- Perform installation, configuration, maintenance, and security related activities involving network

- Monitor network performance and ensure system availability and reliability.
- Troubleshoot complex network issues and provide support as needed.
- Collaborate with cybersecurity teams to ensure secure network design and implementation.
- Develop and maintain network documentation, diagrams, and procedures.
- Collaborate with network architects on design, configuration, and documentation of the network.
- Conduct capacity planning and performance tuning.
- Participate in disaster recovery planning and testing.
- Provide technical guidance and mentorship to junior engineers.
- Work with vendors and service providers to resolve issues and manage service delivery.
- Define the scope of project-related milestones in collaboration with project managers and other stakeholders.
