The Dean promotes a collaborative teaching, learning, and working environment that supports students, faculty, and staff, and strengthens partnerships with healthcare providers and community stakeholders across the College district.

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## **Description of Duties and Tasks**

- Provides leadership in developing, implementing, and maintaining curriculum and programs that
  respond to community needs; prepares students for success; and meets the external
  requirements of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges

  specialized accrediting organizations.
