 - o Occupational Therapists (OTs): Minimum of a Bachelor's degree in Occupational Therapy
- Current license as an Occupational Therapy Assistant or Occupational Therapist in Washington State or ability to secure the license prior to employment.
- Two years of clinical practice experience.
- Registered by National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT)
- Ability to teach OTA specific courses in a variety of content areas.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- 5 or more years of clinical practice experience.
- Teaching expertise, evidence of excellence in teaching.

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Adjunct faculty must work two (2) consecutive quarters at 50% or more of full-time academic load in order to qualify for benefits (based on instructional hours only). Once determined to be eligible, benefits begin on the first day of the month following the beginning of the quarter. Medical, dental, life and long term disability insurance benefits are provided as currently administered under Public Employees Benefits Board; TIAA-Cref retirement plan or WA State Retirement Plan; leave accruals and usage are governed by the faculty master contract.
