Ideal candidates will bring a strong clinical background and proven expertise in delivering engaging, practical, and certification-aligned training. These courses prepare students for the Dental Assistant National Board (DANB) credential, covering Infection Control, Anatomy Morphology and Physiology, Radiation Health and Safety, and related areas. Classes may be offered during daytime and/or evening hours at the Community College of Philadelphia.

- Documentation & Assessment: Document student attendance, monitor performance, and evaluate progress using established assessment methods. Maintain accurate records of student learning outcomes and support preparation for credentialing.
- Clinical & Administrative Support: Support the work of the Dental Assistant program by
  monitoring equipment, ordering supplies, providing chairside assistance, and ensuring safe and
  effective lab/clinic operations.
- Commitment to Mission: Demonstrate a sense of connection and responsibility for helping the College achieve success through a commitment to its mission, vision, and values.
- Technology Integration: Demonstrate appropriate use of instructional technology and other tools to support the teaching and learning process. Incorporate learning management systems and relevant technologies to enhance student learning.

- Demonstrated ability to use instructional technology and support student learning required.
