- Submit required student reports to the Dual Credit and Admissions & Records Office.
- Direct, evaluate, assess, and report the learning outcomes of the students in a timely manner as required by Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges and The Higher Education Coordinating Board in accordance with adopted curricula and approved procedures.
- Provide counsel/guidance to students when there is a need.
- Participate in Campus and Dual Enrollment Office professional development, in addition to any other activities specific to subject area.
- Use the same textbook as selected and approved by the department.
- Verify class roster by the day of record.
- Submit grades to the Lee College Dual Credit Office in a timely manner: pass or fail (P/F) every three (3) weeks; and final numeric grades per due dates set by the college.
