- GIS Intern will assist in projects to enhance the ability of TxGIO to serve data to the public.

- Projects primarily include digitization, cataloguing, and data management of the TxGIO Historic Imagery Archive, development of derivative data products, participating in georeferencing and QAQC of the TxGIO eoreferencing pilot project.
- Additional work may include QAQC and supportive work of various StratMap projects including Orthoimagery, Lidar, Land Cover, Land Parcel & Address Point and Digital Twin data.
